Our school year is just flying by! It's that time of the year again to start thinking about obtaining our Princess/Brave positions for the upcoming year. I would like to let everyone know how you can enter the contest. First, you will have to think about why you would like to become Princess/Brave for our Fond du Lac Reservation. Second, you will have to think about how you will honor this position. Third, you will have to think about if you become princess/brave how will you represent yourself and uphold a very honorable position for the Fond du Lac Reservation.

The contest will be held at our Annual Pow Wow which is going to be on May 7, 2010. There will be more information on the Pow Wow a little later on. Right now I want to let everyone know the rules for entering the Princess/Brave contest.

Rules:

- ❖ Write a one page essay on why you would like to enter, how will you honor having this position, and what will you do when becoming princess/brave.
- ❖ Must be enrolled FDL band member or an Enrolled student attending the FDL Ojibwe School.
- ❖ Do an Ojibwe Language introduction speech at the Pow Wow.
- ❖ Dance/Regalia Contest at the Pow Wow.

As being a contestant for the Princess/Brave Contest you will also have to follow the Parent/Student Hand book rules of the School you attend. What we will be looking at are:

- ❖ Grades
- ❖ Attendance
- ❖ Behavior

Good luck to everyone! The one page essays and your permission slip will have to be turned in by April 16, 2010. If the student is in the 6th grade they will be competing for Sr. Princess/Brave because you will hold the position until next year if becoming the Sr. Princess/Brave. The 6th grade students will be in the High school the following year. You can pick up a Application and permission slip in the administration office located at the Fond du Lac Ojibwe School.
