Class Covers

- State and tribal laws on car seats and seat belt usage.
- Selection of the correct child passenger seat.
- Proper installation of child passenger seats in motor vehicles.
- Provides child passenger seats to children in the Fond du Lac Reservation service area.



Statistics

- Native Americans are at an increased risk of motor-vehicle related injury and death with rates 1.5 to 3 times higher than other Americans.
- Motor-vehicle crashes is listed by Indian Health Services as the leading cause of unintentional injury/death within Minnesota Tribes.
- 72% of nearly 3,500 observed car and booster seats were misused.
- Child safety seats reduce the risk of death by 71% for infants, and by 54% for toddlers.

Participants must

- * Schedule an appointment.
 - * Arrive on time.
- * Bring cash in the exact amount for each car seat or booster needed.

Cost of Seats

- * \$25.00 for each car seat
- * \$5.00 for each booster
