Hello All Bois Forte,

The Bois Forte TERO (Tribal Employment Rights Office) is currently seeking 19 applicants to receive CDL (Commercial Driver's License) Class A or Class B training at no cost to the qualified participants at Hibbing Community College starting February 5, 2019. The Bois Forte Tribal Government has entered into two (2) agreements with the State of Minnesota to provide this training. The first agreement is MnDot Partnership Agreement #1030206 with the second being Mn Employment and Economic Development (DEED) Contract #138004. At present, the MnDot Agreement will train seven (7) participants with the DEED Agreement training twelve (12) participants. The classroom training is identical for each grant but they differ and are defined as follows:

1. The MnDot Partnership Agreement #1030306 with the Bois Forte Tribal Government is for the purpose of providing transportation Highway Heavy Occupations Training to Bois Forte tribal members to work on future Highway Heavy Construction Projects within the State of Minnesota. To qualify for training under this grant the participant must be a Bois Forte tribal member, a descendant of a Bois Forte tribal member, or a Bois Forte tribal members' spouse who is not native. Also the participant must be 18 years old, have a valid Mn driver's license, pass a MnDot physical, pass a MnDot drug screening and meet other requirements set forth by the Bois Forte Tribal Government. 2. The Mn Employment and Economic Development Grant-Contract #1030206 with the Bois Forte Tribal Government states that Bois Forte TERO will provide members of federally recognized tribes with construction/construction type related industry training to assist native in becoming more employable in the construction related industry. To qualify for this training the participant the must be a Bois Forte member or be a tribal band member of a federally recognized tribe. Also the participant must be 18 years old, have a valid Mn driver's license, pass a MnDot physical, pass a MnDot drug screening and meet other requirements set forth by the Bois Forte Tribal Government. Please note that the Bois Forte Clinic at Nett Lake and Vermilion are certified by the State to perform the MnDot Physicals and Drug Screening. Monies from each grant pay for this expense.

If you feel you qualify and want to participate in this training please fill out the HCC CDL Packet and return the application to Dave Anderson at the Nett Lake Tribal Government Building. The HCC application and copies of MnDot physical and Drug test are due in the Nett Lake TERO Office by no later than Monday **January 28, 2019 at 4:30 pm.**
