COVID-19 Vaccine Eligibility Requirements

Must be age 18+

UPDATED 3/24/2021

Patients must meet one of these eligibility requirements: Not required to live in the service area

- Fond du Lac Enrollee & their house members (non-Indians included)
- 1st & 2nd Generation Descendent of FDL Enrollee & their household members (non-Indians included)
- Any Enrolled Member of a US Federal Recognized Tribe (limited to availability)
- Fond du Lac Employees & their household members

Or

MUSI be living in the Fond du Lac Service Area AND:

- Any Enrolled Member of a US Federally Recognized Tribe & their household members (non-Indians included)
- 1st & 2nd Generation Descendent of a US Federally Recognized Tribe & their household members (non-Indians included)
- Canadian Indians

Non-Indian household members must provide proof of residency for a period of at least 30 days prior to receiving services.

Fond du Lac Service Area includes Carlton County, and some of Southern St. Louis County. If you are unsure if your address is within the service area, please contact FDL Human Services Registration at (218) 879-1227.
