Dear Needing Help,

This message occurs when you attempt to insert rows or columns in a worksheet, and the option **nothing (hide objects)** is selected under the **For objects, show** section in the **Excel Options** dialog box. Although this option is not selected by default, it's possible to set it accidentally by pressing the keyboard shortcut (Ctrl + 6). Try doing Ctrl + 6 and see if that works.

If not, click the Microsoft Office Button , and then click Excel Options. Select the Advanced tab. Scroll to Display options for this workbook setting. Under For objects, show: select **All** instead of **Nothing (hide objects)**.



Now you should be able to add that row or column again. Hope this helps...DSG
